22	keeping those same materials from entering the solid waste stream.
23	B. The Legislature finds it is in the public interest to create
24	the Oklahoma Recyclable Container Initiative (ORCI) because:

- There exists a robust interstate and intrastate market for 2 recyclable containers which are produced and used by many Oklahoma 3 | industries and current demand far exceeds the available supply;
- 4 The economic challenges facing our state's municipalities, 5 counties and other entities responsible for the collection and 6|disposal of solid waste are severe and ongoing and the ORCI will 7|provide an opportunity to evaluate current solid waste collection 8|and disposal methods and possibly reduce costs for those entities;
