What Is Recycle-Bowl? Recycle-Bowl Goals

Recycle-Bowl is a free competition and benchmarking tool for K-12 school recycling programs to promote waste reduction activities. School recycling programs across the nation compete in a race to collect the most recyclables.

Whether a school has an extensive recycling program or is just launching basic recycling collections, Recycle-Bowl is an excellent way for teachers, student green teams and facility managers to engage their school community in a fun and friendly way.

2012 Initial Results

- Over 1558 schools registered (equaling over 1.2% of all US schools) in all 50 states and DC
- More than 1,000,000 students will be reached
- 25% increase in participation over last year
- 90% are public schools and 10% private/charter
- 53% of schools are elementary, 18% middle and 19%
- 1% of participants are using the competition to start a school recycling program
- 21% of participating schools do not have a hauling partner
