Nomination Form Descriptions

These descriptions are available to help understand potential nominees for each category; a nominee does not have to necessarily meet the descriptions below to be considered as a winner for the category. An individual, group, or business can be nominated for multiple categories when applicable. Note: A winner may not be selected for every category available.

Recycler of the Year

This award can be for any individual that:

- · Has gone above and beyond to encourage and promote recycling
- Has helped begin or facilitate a recycling program at a local organization
- · Has demonstrated their own commitment to recycling

Green Recycling Business

This award can be for any business that:

- Has gone above and beyond to promote waste reduction and the proper disposal of waste by implementing or improving a recycling program
- Has implemented green programs focused on waste reduction, reuse of materials, composting, proper disposal of hazardous waste, or recycling
- Has educated and involved employees on recycling at the organization
- Has kept records on their progress with their green programs
- Has publicly shown their company's commitment to being green

Green Government

This award can be for any governmental entity that:

- · Has gone above and beyond to promote recycling and proper disposal of waste in their respective community
- · Has coordinated programs and events to encourage community members to properly dispose of their waste
- Has incorporated recycling or composting into their events or agency offices
- Has demonstrated a commitment to protecting the environment and promoting green activities

Green School

This award can be for any school that:

- Has students and/or faculty who have gone above and beyond to promote green handling of waste in their school(s)
- · Has begun programs focused on recycling, waste reduction, reuse, or composting
- Has educated students and faculty on proper waste disposal and has encouraged involvement

Environmental Student

This award can be for a grade school up to university student that:

- Has gone above and beyond to promote and encourage waste reduction and recycling at their respective school or in the community
- · Has helped with the implementation of green projects, events, or programs in their area
- · Has demonstrated their own commitment to recycling and sustainability

Green Non-Profit

This award can be for any non-profit organization that:

- Has gone above and beyond to promote waste reduction, recycling, and proper disposal of waste by implementing or improving related programs
- Has implemented green programs focused on waste reduction, reuse of materials, composting, proper disposal of hazardous waste, or recycling
- Has educated employees on recycling and has encouraged involvement
- Has kept records on their progress with their green programs
- Has publicly shown their organization's commitment to being green

Green Event

This award can be for any event that:

- Has gone above and beyond to promote waste reduction, recycling, and the green handling of waste at the event
- · Has made sure that members of the public attending had access to recycling at the event
- Has demonstrated their commitment to being green

Green Project of the Year

This award can be for individuals or groups that:

- Have gone above and beyond to implement green programs involving the reduction, reuse, upcycling, and recycling
 of materials or organic waste
- Have advocated for and encouraged involvement in their green project
- Have recorded their progress in waste reduction, reuse, or recycling with their project
